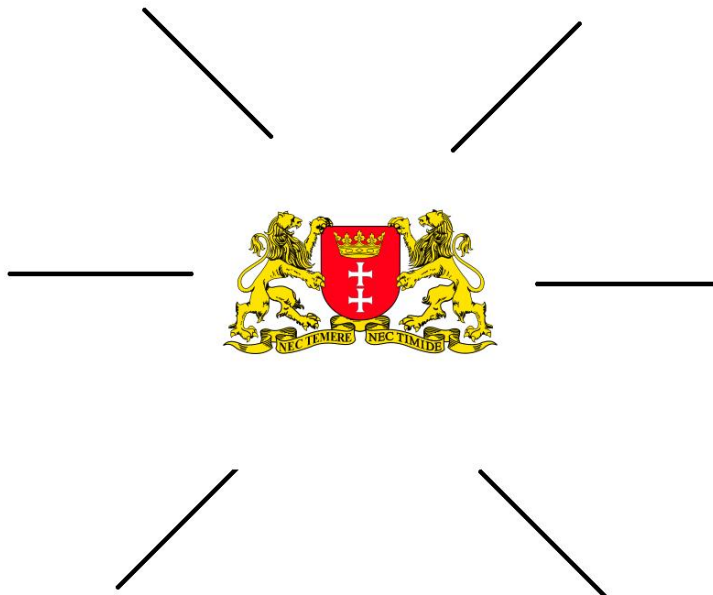
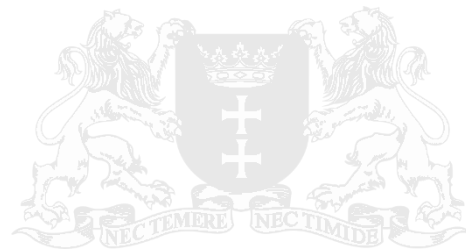

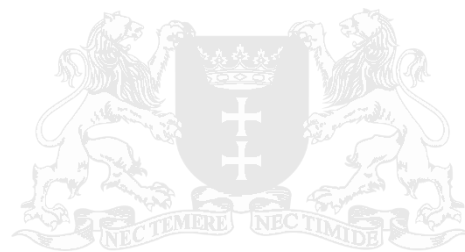
2 Look at the map of Poland. Where exactly is Gdańsk?
